- After you submit your membership application, you will be contacted to advise if your Court has covered your **membership fee** or whether you need to pay an individual membership fee.
- The Komiti/Executive will then **decide your application** is eligible (i.e. confirming you are an appointed member of your judiciary and that a membership fee has been paid by you or on your behalf).
- You will be contacted by the PAWJO Secretariat (Pacific Justice Sector Programme) **confirming your membership status.**
